

Beaver County, Oklahoma
County Commissioners Proceedings
June 20, 2023

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on June 20, 2023. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on June 15, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Fleming called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Roy Fleming, Chairman; Kerry Regier, Vice-Chairman; C.J. Rose, Member, Reuben Parker, Scott Mitchell, Albert Rodriguez, Shelly Thomas, Tammie Patzkowsky, Chuck Lemieux and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the minutes of the June 12, 2023 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Rose, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Rose to approve the contract between Western Plain Youth & Family services and the Board of Beaver County Commissioners to provide juvenile detention services in Woodward Oklahoma at a rate of \$68.00 per child per day. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Rose, Aye and Dearmin, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the Cooperative Agreement with Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry Wildlife Services Division and Board of Beaver County Commissioners. A rate of \$2,400.00 to be paid from Beaver County for expenditures for predator and rodent services. Term is from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Rose, Aye and Regier, Aye.

10:00 ~ Elected Officials discussion regarding Estimate of Needs and requests for FY24 Budget. Each officer went over their requests. The County Clerk and Assessor requested to have another full-time employee in their offices. The Sheriff asked for raises for his Dispatchers, Secretary and Undersheriff. The Election Board received raises in May which is state mandated. The General Gov. Employee benefits will increase some from last year. Everything else will remain pretty much the same as last year's budget. Another meeting will be held after our budget maker starts working on the budget to see if the requests can be met.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to accept a Donation from Seaboard Foods LLC on behalf of Beaver County Fire Departments in the amount of \$600.00, Receipt #661, deposited in the following Fire Department Accounts as follows: Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.

The Nursing Home inadvertently stated the meals would be \$6.00 each when they should be \$7.00. This contract will be in affect from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. The previous contract dated June 5, 2023 is null and void. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Regier, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Re-Appointment of Kerry Patzkowsky was on the agenda for the Beaver County Hospital Board. Regier stated that Patzkowsky will not seek re-appointment. No action taken on this agenda item.

He will return next week after we receive the Resolution from ACCO for renewal of Property and Liability Coverages to be placed on the agenda.
