10:30 ~ School Superintendents as well as Barclay Holt, Brent Haken and Justin Lockwood met with the Board to answer any question regarding the Resolution for the Board to approve the State Board of Career and Technology Education to call for an Election to be held in Beaver County to annex Beaver County to High Plains Technology. Barkley did report that they have been out to visit all the Beaver County Schools and all have buildings or rooms available to facilitate programs. This would include the TAPS programs that would be available to grades ranging from 6<sup>th</sup> grade to 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Different programs will be implemented at each school. Once up and operating full time programs will be offered at Beaver and Turpin Schools including post-secondary programs. Patzkowsky asked how long a class lasts each day. For a high school junior or senior it is a half a day. For election purposes they take care of everything and take care of all expenses incurred for the Election. They also notify all entities that are required to be notified in any Election. Jusin Lockwood who is taking care of all the election paperwork will keep us all updated and be in contact with Christi Lausden, Election Board Secretary. Commissioners relayed thus far they have heard positive comments regarding implementing this program in Beaver County. The Commissioners also feel like it would be beneficial to have the Oklahoma Career Tech representatives come to Beaver to speak with the public and give a clear picture on what all this entails.


