The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on April 1, 2024. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on March 28, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West, and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Regier called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Those presents were Kerry Regier, Chairman; C.J. Rose, Vice-Chairman; Roy Fleming, Member; Reuben Parker, Scott Mitchell and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Regier and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the March 25, 2024 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Rose, Aye and Fleming, Aye.
