Bids will be received until **March 18, 2016 at 5:00 P.M.** in the Beaver County Clerk's Office of the Beaver County Courthouse in Beaver, Oklahoma.

Said bids will be publicly opened and considered by the Board of Beaver County Commissioners in the Commissioner's Office on the **21st day of March, 2016 at 11:00 A.M.** with the right being reserved to reject any or all bids.

The following criteria should be met when submitting a bid:

1. The bid shall be made on the enclosed "Invitation to Bid" and the Affidavit of Non-Collusion must be signed and notarized.
2. All prices quoted shall be F.O.B. Beaver County.
3. Place your bid in a sealed envelope clearly marked, "**SEALED BID #3**". This insures that the bid will not be voided due to accidental opening.
4. On all bids requiring services or contract labor, proof of liability insurance with at least \$1,000,000.00 liability and Workmen's Compensation is required. If you cannot furnish these you must furnish us with a Certificate of Non-Coverage.
5. **All bids on public construction contracts exceeding \$50,000.00 shall accompany the bid with a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond equal to 5% of the bid, which shall be deposited with the awarding public agency as a guaranty. Or, an irrevocable letter of credit issued by a financial institution, insured by the FDIC on behalf of the awarding public agency, in an amount equal to 5% of the bid.**
6. **Contract will not be executed until all bonds (Payment, Performance and Warranty) and insurance are provided.**

**SPECIFICATIONS FOR
TURPIN FIRE STATION
BUILDING & CONCRETE**

GENERAL: This bid is for the construction of Turpin Fire Station, **as shown on drawing provided (not to scale)**, must include all of the following specifications.

Building:

- One (1) 40' x 50' pre-engineered rigid steel framed building including
 - 14' Eave Height
 - Outside wall panels shall be color selected by Owner
 - Roof panels shall be steel interlocked and color selected by Owner
 - Minimum of 2" vinyl backed insulation for walls & ceiling
 - Insulation to be secured, properly in place
 - Guttering & downspouts also provided & installed
- Two (2) Truck Doors 14' Wide by 12' High with Electric Door Openers
- One (1) 3'0" x 6'8" or 3'0" x 7'0" commercial steel entry door and frame without glass
- Final building layout to be approved by Owner

Concrete:

- 42' X 54' X 6" concrete slab, 3000# mix, capable of handling large trucks with a center drain. **(Slope of concrete and location of drain to be determined by Owner)**
- 12" x 20" minimum footing continuous for a 40' X 50' building
- Approximately 16" x 16" x 24" piers for main building supports to accommodate the approved building requirements **(Anchor bolts provided by building contractor)**
- #4 rebar on 20" spacing both ways in slab
- #4 slab dowels 28" long on 36" centers
- 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 block out around perimeter for sheet panels
- 1 1/2 x 6" block out for 14' x 12' doors
- Plumbing stubbed inside & outside of slab **(Plumbing and water line to be determined by Owner)**
- A 5' cement approach along the front of the building
