Bids will be opened on June 3, 2024 at 9:30 a.m. Bids must be received in **sealed envelopes with “6 month bid #2A” and closing date written on the **outside** of the envelope. The items listed herein are to be used as a guide for the Bidders agreement to sell, and shall not be considered as the County’s agreement to buy. However, it is anticipated that the County will buy the majority of the items listed within the time specified. **All items shall be in compliance with the required Oklahoma State Department of Transportation and Federal materials specifications.****

DELIVERY

The bidders, whose proposal is accepted, shall deliver the items, in such quantities and to such locations within Beaver County. Delivery must be within (10) days from the date of the order. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

2. Late bids will not be considered. Bids must be received in sealed envelopes (one to an envelope) with bid number and closing date written on the outside of the envelope.
3. Unit prices will be guaranteed correct by the bidder.
4. Firm prices will be F.O.B. destination.
5. Purchases by Beaver County, Oklahoma, are not subject to state or federal taxes.
6. This bid is submitted as a legal offer and any bid when accepted by the County constitutes a firm contract.
7. Oklahoma laws require each bidder submitting a bid to a county for goods or services to furnish a notarized sworn statement of non-collusion. A form is supplied below.
