Beaver County, Oklahoma County Commissioners Proceedings April 23, 2018

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on April 23, 2018. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on April 19, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Regier called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Kerry Regier, Chairman; Brad Raven, Vice-Chairman; C. J. Rose, Member; Reuben Parker, Jr.; Scott Mitchell; Robin Barby and Lisa Bennett, County Clerk.

Motion was made by Raven and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the April 16, 2018 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Raven, Aye and Rose, Aye.

9:00 ~ Robin Barby, Beaver County Nursing Home Administrator was present to discuss continuing to provide inmate meals for the Sheriff's Office. The County currently pays \$5.50 per meal, per inmate, three times daily. Should the jail be at capacity, the number of meals needed could potentially be 17,520 annually. Barby is proposing a 4% increase beginning July 1, 2018, at a cost of \$5.75 per meal. This proposal will raise the annual cost to \$100,740.00, from \$96,360.00, an increase of \$4,380.00, based on 16 inmates daily. Once the Board receives the preliminary budget, a decision will be made.

Motion was made by Raven and seconded by Rose to approve the Renewal of the fourteen (14) day Beaver County Burn Ban. Said ban will remain on the Board's weekly agenda for discussion and possible removal, in a regular or special meeting, before the fourteen (14) day period ends if conditions change. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Raven, Aye and Rose, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to approve the FY19 Contract between the Sac and Fox Nation Juvenile Detention Center and Board of Co. Commissioners, whereas Beaver County agrees to pay \$21.11 daily per child for services. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Raven, Aye and Rose, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to approve Requests for Purchase Orders from General Government Sales Tax Account #Cash-66F as follows. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Raven, Aye and Rose, Aye.
