 County Commissioners Proceedings
 March 3, 2008

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on March 3, 2008. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on February 28, 2008 at 4:00 p.m. at all three entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Raven called the meeting to order. Those present were Brad Raven, Chairman; C. J. Rose, Acting Member; Richard Cowan, Member; Karen Schell, County Clerk/Secretary, Darrell Looper, Mechille Calhoun, Dayla Pugh, Rick Nelson, Sharon Raven, Denise Janko, Vera Floyd and Keith Shadden.

Motion was made by Cowan and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the February 29, 2008 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Cowan to approve the monthly report for the Court Clerk. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

9:30 Darrell Looper with Colvin Mills met with the Commissioners. Mr. Looper reviewed the current values per square foot of the buildings and suggested a few increases. Motion was made by Cowan and seconded by Rose to approve the increases. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
