The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on January 20, 2009. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information January 16, 2009 at 4:00 p.m. at all three entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.
