

Beaver County, Oklahoma
 County Commissioners Proceedings
 May 3, 2010

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on May 3, 2010. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on April 29, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. at two entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order. Those present were C. J. Rose, Chairman; Brad Raven, Member; Richard Cowan, Member, Karen Schell, County Clerk/Secretary, Dayla Pugh, Sharon Raven, Mechille Calhoun, Denise Janko, Vera Floyd and Rodney Seawright.

Motion was made by Raven and seconded by Cowan to approve the minutes of the April 30, 2010 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to approve the proposed sidewalk change for the courthouse addition. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

10:00 County Officer meeting was held. Vera Floyd said the Election Board was getting a lot of registrations. She also said the filing period for Treasurer, Assessor, Commissioner Dist. 1 and Commissioner Dist. 3 will be June 7, 8, 9, 2010. Denise Janko said they were starting their new Library hours today and also the new help was starting today. She said they were still looking for part time help. Dayla Pugh said things were running smooth in the Assessor's office. Informal protest period for real estate ends this week. She said they have had a few protests after the valuation change notices went out. Karen Schell said her office has had a lot of land men working. She also said to remind the employees of the screening coming up May 12 & 13th and to encourage them to take advantage of it. Brad Raven said the prescription card saving since we started has saved the county residents \$483.00 so far. C. J. Rose said that Dist. 2 was busy patching blacktops that needed it and haven't been able to get very much grading done. He also said there was progress being made on the courthouse construction. Rose asked Seawright when the north door would be in. Seawright said they were waiting on the grates. He said the grating costs \$76.80 per sq. ft. Rose informed Seawright that they approved the sidewalk proposal and he could proceed with the change order.

Seawright presented the Commissioners with a change order for the sidewalk and trench drains in the amount of \$4,273.00 and a change in the sump pump at elevator in the amount of \$2,685.00. Motion was made by Cowan and seconded by Raven to approve the change order. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
