Beaver County, Oklahoma County Commissioners Proceedings June 1, 2010

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on June 1, 2010. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on May 28, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. at the East entrance to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order. Those present were C. J. Rose, Chairman; Richard Cowan, Member, Karen Schell, County Clerk/Secretary, Dayla Pugh, Sharon Raven, Vera Floyd, Mechille Calhoun, and Reuben Parker, Jr.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Cowan to approve the minutes of the May 28, 2010 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

10:00 County Officer meeting was held. Vera Floyd said the filing period for Commissioners Dist. 1 & Dist. 3, Treasurer & Assessor will be June 7, 8, & 9. Rueben Parker, Jr. said they set a record with only five in jail at this time. He also said the jail inspector advised him to start charging the inmates through the commissary for their toilet paper. He said the inmates were filling cracks with it and making chess sets out of it. Parker said he is also working on a grant through the District Attorney's Council for \$10,000.00 for bullet proof vests that will be a reimbursement grant. Dayla Pugh said that her office will be doing revaluation work this month. She also said she has to have her abstract done and in to the state by June 15. Mechille Calhoun said the resale will be held June 14 and will have possibly 3 properties. She also said the taxes were coming in slow this year. Karen Schell said that Deborah Radcliff mentioned in the Excise Board meeting that they would like for the county officers to try to balance as much of the budget as possible on their own before the final budget meeting since it worked so well that way last year. Rose said the insurance premiums are increasing 6% and the retirement is increasing 1%. He also said the personal property valuations were down. Schell said all the collections were down also. Pugh said the personal property was down due to no one buying cattle or equipment. It was agreed by all making the budget was going to be hard this year. Rose said the court house project was moving along also.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Cowan to reappoint Cowan to a three year term as representative on the OEDA Board of Trustees for Beaver County. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Cowan to approve the monthly reports for the Treasurer's investments, Treasurer's Mortgage Tax Report, County Clerk and the Fair Board report for April & May. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Cowan and seconded by Rose to approve two applications for road crossings from Unit Petroleum Co. in the NE/4 of Section 18-2N-22ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Cowan and seconded by Rose to approve a location for construction of buried telephone facilities from PTCI between Sections 27 & 28-2N-21ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Cowan and seconded by Rose to approve a location for construction of buried telephone facilities from PTCI between Sections 18 & 19-4N-24ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Cowan and seconded by Rose to deposit the following checks in the Treasurer's Office. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Pursuant to Title 62 § 335 notice is given for a reimbursement to the Transit Bus account 63D for the sale of the used transit bus in the amount of \$2,500.00. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Cowan and seconded by Rose to approve a resolution to execute the agreement establishing the ACCO SIF Fund for worker's comp insurance and the intent to participate for FY 2011 in the amount of \$49,375.00. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
