The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on October 4, 2010. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on September 30, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. at the East entrance to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order. Those present were C. J. Rose, Chairman; Brad Raven, Member; Richard Cowan, Member; Karen Schell, County Clerk/Secretary, Dayla Pugh, Sharon Raven, Mechille Calhoun, Keith Shadden, Reuben Parker, Jr. and Robin Fast and Heather Shrvock with the State Auditor & Inspector's Office.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to approve the minutes of the September 30, 2010 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

10:00 County Officer meeting was held. Robin Fast & Heather Shryock with State Auditor's Office presented the engagement letter for the audit for 2008, 2009 and 2010. Discussions on the letter and audit procedures took place. Robin & Heather left the meeting. Shadden said he was working on the State declaration. Parker said he had 2 empty beds in the female side. He said he had talked to JJ's Plumbing and McMichaels Plumbing to get more estimates on the plumbing issue. Parker said they had also seized 550 lbs. marijuana found in a vehicle stopped by a trooper. He said the task force has started forfeiture on the Ford pickup. Calhoun said that Gate & Knowles have not picked up their budgets. Rose said the Commissioners felt like there should only be quarterly officer meetings. If an officer needs to discuss anything they can come in any time. They felt like it would be a cost savings to only meet quarterly. Rose also said there would be someone with OSU here in a few weeks to do a presentation on the last 10 years of the county budget and give ideas on where we might be headed. Brad Raven said that OSU has offered to do an open meeting class for the sales tax entities that might need it.
