Beaver County, Oklahoma County Commissioners Proceedings October 31, 2011

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on October 31, 2011. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on October 27, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. at the East and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order. Those present were C. J. Rose, Chairman; Brad Raven, Member; Frank King, Member; Mark Janzen, Abby Cash, ADA; Keith Shadden and Tammy Millikan, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Raven and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the October 24, 2011 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to purchase one motor grader from Bid #2, tabled from the October 24, 2011 meeting from Yellowhouse Machinery Co. for Dist. #2. Base Machine Price was \$255,976.00 with the trade of a 2007 JD 672D Motor Grader, Serial #DW672DX611046 in the amount of \$135,000, with a balance of \$120,976.00 obiligated on the Lease Purchase Agreement between Board of County Commissioners and Yellowhouse Machinery Co. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
