Beaver County, Oklahoma County Commissioners Proceedings August 6, 2012

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on August 6, 2012. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on August 2, 2012 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order. Those present were C. J. Rose, Chairman; Frank King, Member; Brad Raven, Member; Rick Nelson, Mike Ruby, Ryan Davis, Trevor Townsend, Scott Harrington, Rodney Seawright, Bruce Williams and Tammy Millikan, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the July 31, 2012 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

After discussion regarding the county wide burn ban, which was renewed for a thirty (30) day period on July 23, 2012, motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to leave the ban in effect and continue reviewing the status on a weekly basis. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

9:15 ~ Rick Nelson, OSU Extension Director, presented for approval the FY13 Cooperative Extension Services Agreement between OSU, on behalf of it's Cooperative Extension Service, and the Board of Beaver Co. Commissioners. Motion was made by Raven and seconded by King to approve said contract. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

9:30 ~ Mike Ruby, Ryan Davis, Trevor Townsend and Scott Harrington, representing OG&E met with the Board to update them on the progress of the transmission line which will be installed in Beaver County. Construction will begin in November, 2012 with the estimated completion being in 2014. They will soon begin the permitting process and the Board requested to review all road crossings prior to construction. The final route of the transmission line was also presented to the Board.

10:00 ~ Rodney Seawright, Architect, and Bruce Williams, Kline Mechanical Contracting, gave the Board an update on the progress of the Courthouse Addition. Williams stated that the concrete work should be complete this week and the vault door openings for the County Clerk will be cut over the coming weekend. The electrical work should be complete this week and the last air conditioner, located in the Judge's office, will be installed on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Seawright asked Williams if they were still on schedule for a September 1<sup>st</sup> completion date and Williams said they should be and will report again at the August 13<sup>th</sup> meeting.
