The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on September 10, 2012. After discussion regarding the county wide burn ban, which was renewed for a thirty (30) day period on August 20, 2012, motion was made by King and seconded by Raven to leave the ban in effect and continue reviewing the status on a weekly basis. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
