

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on October 1, 2012. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on September 27, 2012 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order. Those present were C. J. Rose, Chairman; Frank King, Member; Brad Raven, Member; Keith Shadden, Bruce Williams and Tammy Millikan, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the September 28, 2012 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

After discussion with Keith Shadden, Emergency Management Director, regarding the county wide burn ban, which was renewed for a thirty (30) day period on September 17, 2012, motion was made by Raven and seconded by King to cancel the ban at this time. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Raven and seconded by Rose to approve a Resolution to Establish Longevity Pay for Employees of Beaver County, following O.S. 74 § 840-2.18. Said pay is to be presented each year in the November pay period to qualifying employees, if funds are determined to be available during the annual budget meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Bruce Williams, Kline Mechanical Contracting, gave the Board an update on the progress of the Courthouse Addition. He is still attempting to obtain quotes regarding the flooring change and will look into the cause of problems locking some of the doors.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve the monthly report for Treasurer's Mortgage Tax. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
