Beaver County, Oklahoma County Commissioners Proceedings January 14, 2013

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on January 14, 2013. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on January 10, 2013 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

King called the meeting to order. Those present were Frank King, Chairman; Brad Raven, Member; C. J. Rose, Member; Darrell Looper, Denise Janko, Britt Stubblefield, Zach Burkey and Tammy Millikan, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the January 7, 2013 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
