County Commissioners Proceedings  
February 28, 2013

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on February 28, 2013. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on February 27, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and [www.beaver.okcounties.org](http://www.beaver.okcounties.org).

The February 25, 2013 meeting was cancelled due to the Courthouse being closed from inclement weather, therefore all agenda items were transferred to the February 28, 2013 agenda.

King called the meeting to order. Those present were Frank King, Chairman; Brad Raven, Member; C. J. Rose, Member; Gary Riffe and Tammy Millikan, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to approve the minutes of the February 19, 2013 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

11:00 ~ Bid #11, purchasing a pumper for Turpin Fire Dept. was opened with Gary Riffe, Turpin Fire Chief, in attendance. Bids were received from Emergency Vehicle Resources in the amount of \$47,500 and Jon's Mid America Fire Apparatus in the amount of \$57,500. Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to table the bid award until the March 4, 2013 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by King to approve an Application for Road Crossing from Unit Petroleum Co. between Sections 6 & 7-1N-24ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Raven to approve an Application for Road Crossing from Unit Petroleum Co. between Sections 2 & 11-3N-21ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve an Application for Road Crossing from Unit Petroleum Co. between Sections 29 & 30-1N-22ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve an Application for Road Crossing (Water Disposal Line) from Unit Petroleum Co. between Sections 19 & 30-1N-22ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve an Application for Road Crossing (Gas Sales Line) from Unit Petroleum Co. between Sections 19 & 30-1N-22ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve an Application for Road Crossing from Unit Petroleum Co. between Sections 26 & 35-2N-20ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by King to approve an Application for Road Crossing from Dynamic Oilfield Services Co. between Sections 8 & 18-3N-23ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Raven to approve an Application for Road Crossing from Partners Oilfield Services between Sections 25-5N-21ECM & 30-5N-22ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Following discussion regarding employee salaries, motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to raise the hourly wage of all highway employees by 75¢ per hour beginning with March payroll. There will also be requests in the 2013-2014 budget for the equivalent to this raise for the General Fund employees, if funds are available. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Raven and seconded by Rose to approve the monthly reports (December & January) for the Assessor. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

As per O.S. 62 1991 § 335, the County Clerk gives notice of a reimbursement into General Gov. Sales Tax Acct. #66G in the amount of \$5,000.00. Said reimbursement is from the Dist. Attorney for partial reimbursement for their portion of the Courthouse Addition construction costs.

Rose & King gave notice of their Districts beginning summer hours, being ten hour days, Monday through Thursday, effective April 1, 2013.
