Beaver County, Oklahoma County Commissioners Proceedings September 3, 2013

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on September 3, 2013. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on August 29, 2013 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

King called the meeting to order. Those present were Frank King, Chairman; C. J. Rose, Member; Brad Raven, Member; Kirk Fisher, Justin Carnagey, Mike Bostic, Tom Sheats, Keith Shadden and Tammy Millikan, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to approve the minutes of the August 30, 2013 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve an Application for Road Crossing from DCP Midstream, LP between Sections 27 & 34-2N-20ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Notice was given by the Board of a disaster declaration signed and presented to FEMA on August 29, 2013 resulting from the flooding event of August 7-9, 2013, causing major damage to the County's road and infrastructure.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Raven to approve an Application for Road Crossing from DCP Midstream, LP between Sections 7 & 18-1N-21ECM. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

10:00 ~ Kirk Fisher, Justin Carnagey, Mike Bostic and Tom Sheats, representatives of OEDA, met with the Board to discuss the Beaver County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update. Mr. Sheats is the current coordinator for the plan which needs to be updated every five years. The plan, which must be implemented in order to be eligible for grant and disaster funding from FEMA for various programs, is based on 75% (Federal) and 25% (Local) funding. The total estimated cost for the project is \$52,424, consisting of \$13,106 to be provided by the county, cities and schools. Beaver County is committed to \$2,034 financially with the balance of their one-third being provided through in-kind services. Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to enter into an Agreement for Professional Services between Beaver County and Oklahoma Economic Development Authority, whom will coordinate the plan. Motion carried with all members voting aye. Shadden, Beaver Co. Emergency Management Director, also entered into a Maintenance Agreement for the project and the Board sent a notice of application to the Okla. Dept. of Emergency Management.

Carnagey also updated the Board on the pending implementation of the County 911 system. OEDA will be coordinating an informational meeting soon with Cimarron Co., Harper Co. and Beaver Co. and advised the Board of the need to begin the process of appointing a 911 Board. He further advised it would be in the County's best interest to not begin the mapping process before all other details are worked out, in order to prevent costly updates.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Raven to approve the August monthly reports for the Election Board, Health Dept. and Treasurer's Mortgage Tax. Motion carried with all members voting aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to deposit the following checks in the Treasurer's Office. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
