County Commissioners Proceedings
January 12, 2015

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on January 12, 2015. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on January 8, 2015 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Raven called the meeting to order. Those present were Brad Raven, Chairman; Frank King, Vice-Chairman; C. J. Rose, Member; Mike Baker and Tammy Millikan, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the January 5, 2015 meeting. Motion carried with all members voting aye.
