Beaver County, Oklahoma County Commissioners Proceedings March 28, 2016

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on March 28, 2016. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on March 23, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Raven called the meeting to order. Those present were Brad Raven, Chairman; Frank King, Vice-Chairman; C. J. Rose, Member; Brian Langston, Darlene Lansden, Reuben Parker, Jr., Albert Rodriguez, Denise Janko, Keith Shadden, Lisa Bennett, Tammie Patzkowsky, Christi Lansden and Tammy Millikan, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to approve the minutes of the March 21, 2016 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Raven, Aye; King, Aye and Rose, Aye.

9:30 ~ Brian Langston, Cedar Ridge General Contracting, LLC, met with the Board regarding Bid #3, for the construction of a pre-engineered rigid framed building and concrete for Turpin Fire Dept. Cedar Ridge General Contracting, LLC was awarded the bid in the March 21, 2016 meeting. Motion was made by King and seconded by Rose to execute a contract, on behalf of Turpin Fire Dept., with Cedar Ridge General Contracting, LLC for the project to be completed by September 1, 2016. Motion carried with voting; Raven, Aye; King, Aye and Rose, Aye.

 $10:00 \sim \text{County Officers}$ meeting was held with each Officer reporting current activities affecting their office. Rose advised that we will see a 2.5% increase and benefit changes for employee health insurance coverage beginning in fiscal year 16-17.

Rose asked that each officer and department head report any suspected work related injury immediately, even in the event it is not believed to necessitate treatment at the time. This policy could prevent the County from being fined when injuries are not reported in a timely manner and assist if unforeseen treatment is needed at a later date. Raven presented a sample Safety Manual with policies to assist in preventing injuries, as well as reduce claims and costs for insurance. He asked that each officer review the manual for any necessary changes before it is implemented.

Discussion was held regarding the concerns for the upcoming budget year and how the economic issues have impacted the County General Fund, Highway Fund and Sales Tax Fund.

Raven recommended that officers and department heads review all employee timesheets and keep documentation on any time off or time made up for access by the State Auditor & Inspector's Office. Raven further stated "As requested by our State Auditor's Office, the Board would like to ask all Officers and Department Heads if you are aware of any suspicious or fraudulent activity regarding County employees", and none was reported.

Another County Officer's meeting will be held on April 18, 2016 in order to distribute budget request forms, review Safety Manual and begin preparation for the Northwest District County Officer's & Deputies meeting which will be hosted by Beaver County in the fall.

Evaluation and discussion regarding the possible need for a County wide burn ban was held with no action taken at this time, although it will be considered again at the April 4, 2016 meeting.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by King to approve a Request for Purchase Order from General Government Sales Tax Account #Cash-66D as follows. Motion carried with voting; Raven, Aye; King, Aye and Rose, Aye.
