Beaver County, Oklahoma County Commissioners Proceedings December 18, 2017

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on December 18, 2017. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on December 14, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Regier called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Kerry Regier, Chairman; Brad Raven, Vice-Chairman; C. J. Rose, Member; Scott Mitchell, 911 Coordinator; Reuben Parker Jr., Sheriff; Donnie Head, CED #8 and Lisa Bennett, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Raven to approve a Resolution to Call Fair Board Election, with filing period commencing on January 8, 2018 and ending on January 12, 2018. The election shall be held on January 29, 2018 from 1:00 to 3:00 in the Office of Beaver Co. Commissioners, for one position in each Commissioner's district.
