County Commissioners Proceedings
December 21, 2020

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on December 21, 2020. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on December 17, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Fleming called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Roy Fleming, Chairman; Kerry Regier, Vice-Chairman; C.J. Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the December 14, 2020 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Regier, Aye and Rose, Aye.
