9:15 ~ Treasurer Deputy, Kacee Mosburg to discuss serving delinquent personal property tax warrants. The Treasurer prepares delinquent tax warrants for a Sheriff Deputy to serve for personal property tax. In 2019 approximately 160 warrants were prepared by the Treasurer's office and submitted to the Sheriff. The warrants must be served within 60 days. None were served in a timely manner. In 2020, none were served due to the Covid outbreak. The years 18, 19 and 20 were presented with approximately \$38,000.00 owed for delinquent personal property tax. Going forward to 2021 household personal property will no longer be assessed. Personal property will consist of mobile homes, farm equipment, etc. Mosburg presented working with a sheriff deputy to serve the warrants together. Texas County Treasurer works closely with the Sheriff and has found it very effective for a Sheriff Deputy and Treasurer Deputy to serve the warrants together. The commissioners suggested the Treasurer and Sheriff work together to resolve the issue of getting the warrants served. No action taken by the Commissioners.
