

Beaver County, Oklahoma  
County Commissioners Proceedings  
February 7, 2022

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on February 7, 2022. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on February 3, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Those presents were C.J. Rose, Chairman; Roy Fleming, Vice-Chairman; Kerry Regier, Member, Reuben Parker, Scott Mitchell, David Glascock, and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Fleming to approve the minutes of the January 31, 2022 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Rose, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Fleming to approve the ARPA Resolution #7822 determining how funds may be used. Beaver County received monies in the amount of \$515,799.50. A Resolution #7783 was done on June 1, 2021 and money was placed in an interest-bearing account until a final ruling was established as to what the county could use the money for. Whereas in the Final Rule, counties are permitted to elect a fixed amount of revenue loss, not to exceed \$10 million total for the entire period, that can be used to fund government services. Funds will be placed in Account #1566-1-2000-2005. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Regier, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Fleming to approve the Resolution for FY22 State Aid Grant for the Beaver County Library in the amount of \$12,794.00. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Regier, Aye and Rose, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Fleming to approve a Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for *Special Apportionment* for the Library FY22 State Aid Grant in the amount of \$12,794.00, Receipt #394. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Regier, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Regier to amend the FY22 Requesting Officers and Receiving Agents as follows: Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.
