County Commissioners Proceedings  
April 18, 2022

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on April 18, 2022. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on April 14, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and [www.beaver.okcounties.org](http://www.beaver.okcounties.org).

Rose called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were C.J. Rose, Chairman; Roy Fleming, Vice-Chairman; Kerry Regier, Member, Reuben Parker, Scott Mitchell and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.


