County Commissioners Proceedings
July 5, 2022

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on July 5, 2022. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on July 1, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those presents were C.J. Rose, Chairman; Roy Fleming, Vice-Chairman; Kerry Regier, Member; Reuben Parker, Scott Mitchell and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Fleming to approve the minutes of the July 1, 2022 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Regier, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Regier to approve the request from the Sheriff to move Mary Ester Sallee from part time status to full time status effective July 1, 2022. Sallee will be paid out of the E-911 salary account starting at \$2,415.00 per month and after three months move to full salary of \$2,676.95. A special meeting was held by the E-911 Board on June 27, 2022. The Board agreed to pay one Dispatcher salary, minus benefits. The Clerk relayed to the Commissioners it would be better if benefits were paid out of the E-911 account for payroll purposes.
