

Beaver County, Oklahoma
County Commissioners Proceedings
August 5, 2024

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on August 5, 2024. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on August 1, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West, and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Regier called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Those present were Kerry Regier, Chairman; C.J. Rose, Vice-Chairman; Roy Fleming, Member; Reuben Parker, Scott Mitchell and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Regier and seconded by Fleming to approve the minutes of the July 29, 2024 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Rose, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Lemieux entered the meeting to give the Board an update on visual inspection. They have 2,309 properties left to inspect. They have found numerous mobile homes that have not been either reported or entered into their system.

Motion was made by Regier and seconded by Rose to approve the Attorney General Sherrif Funding Grant Application for FY25. Resolution #2024-8213 was approved in the amount of \$250,000.00 that the Sheriff requested. The Grant can be used for purchase of vehicles, supplies and equipment. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Rose, Aye and Regier, Aye.

Motion was made by Regier and seconded by Rose to approve the Sheriff request to hire Dally Conway, effective August 1, 2024 as a part time Dispatcher at \$15.79 per hour for 6 months then will go full time and be paid a monthly salary of \$3,156.62. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Regier, Aye and Rose, Aye.

Motion was made by Regier and seconded by Rose to approve the Sheriff request to hire Sierra Caldwell, effective August 15, 2024 as a part time Dispatcher at \$15.79 per hour for 6 months then will go full time and be paid a monthly salary of \$3,156.62. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Regier, Aye and Rose, Aye.

The Board reviewed the Fire Alarm Inspection Report that was conducted on July 30, 2024. No deficiencies or failures were noted. The panel system does need updated and labeled to ensure the correct information is located is on the panel.
