County Commissioners Proceedings  
March 24, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on March 24, 2025. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on March 20, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and [www.beaver.okcounties.org](http://www.beaver.okcounties.org).

Rose called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were C.J. Rose, Chairman; Roy Fleming, Vice-Chairman; Kerry Regier, Member, Scott Mitchell and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Regier to approve the minutes of the March 17, 2025 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Regier to approve the OEDA Reap Reimbursement form for the Forgan FD Grant BV25-3 for payment to Banner Fire (Chief Fire & Safety Inc.) for the purchase of truck equipment, nozzles, tools and forestry monitor. Payment request #1 in the amount of \$10,402.00. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Rose, Aye and Regier, Aye.
