County Commissioners Proceedings
August 4, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on August 4, 2025. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on July 31, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West, and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Those present were C.J. Rose, Chairman; Roy Fleming, Vice-Chairman; Kerry Regier, Member; Scott Mitchell, Sheriff and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Regier to approve the minutes of the July 28, 2025 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Rose, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Shelly Thomas, Treasurer visited with the board briefly regarding town properties that are condemned and torn down. They relayed the City can still place a mowing tax on the property but not a demolition tax.
