County Commissioners Proceedings
August 18, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on August 18, 2025. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on August 14, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were C.J. Rose, Chairman; Roy Fleming, Vice-Chairman; Kerry Regier, Member; Scott Mitchell, Sheriff and Kelly Yeomans County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Fleming to approve the minutes of the August 11, 2025 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Rose, Aye.
