County Commissioners Proceedings
December 22, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on December 22, 2025. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on December 18, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Rose called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were C.J. Rose, Chairman; Roy Fleming, Vice-Chairman; Kerry Regier, Member, Scott Mitchell, and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Regier to approve the minutes of the December 15, 2025 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.

Motion was made by Rose and seconded by Regier to accept a donation on behalf of Beaver County Fire Departments from XIT Ranch in the amount of \$5,000.00, Receipt #253 deposited in the FD Donation accounts as follows:
