County Commissioners Proceedings
February 23, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on February 23, 2026. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on February 19, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Fleming called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Roy Fleming, Chairman; Kerry Regier, Vice-Chairman; C.J. Rose, Member, Scott Mitchell, Sheriff and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.


The Board relayed that the highway districts will go back to working 10 hour days (Monday-Thursday) effective March 1, 2026.
