County Commissioners Proceedings  
March 16, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on March 16, 2026. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on March 12, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and [www.beaver.okcounties.org](http://www.beaver.okcounties.org).

Fleming called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Roy Fleming, Chairman; Kerry Regier, Vice-Chairman; C.J. Rose, Member; Scott Mitchell, Sheriff; Mary Chris Barth and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the March 9, 2026 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Rose, Aye.

Public Comment: Fleming asked Mary Chris Barth if she had public comment. She does not.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve Resolution #8648 authorizing the calling of an election and continuation of the 1% sales tax and Notice of Election for Beaver County to be held on June 16, 2026 during the Primary Election. The term shall be from April 1, 2027 through March 31, 3033. Resolution was created by DA, George "Buddy" Leach. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.
