County Commissioners Proceedings
May 26, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on May 26, 2026. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on May 21, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Fleming called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Roy Fleming, Chairman; Kerry Regier, Vice-Chairman; C.J. Rose, Member; Scott Mitchell, Sheriff; Mary Chris Barth and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Public Comment: None

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the minutes of the May 18, 2026 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Rose to approve the Resolution to re-appoint Gregory McReynolds to the Beaver County Hospital Authority Board. The term shall be from July 1, 2026 to July 1, 2030. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Regier, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the Resolution to re-appoint Mark Peters to the Beaver County EMS Board. The term shall be from July 1, 2026 to July 1, 2030. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Regier, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the Resolution to appoint Curtis Koehn to the Beaver County Hospital Authority Board to fulfill the remaining term of Eddie Lozano. The term shall be from May 26, 2026 to July 1, 2027. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Regier, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the request of the Sheriff to hire Irven Carl Stout as a full time Deputy Sheriff to be effective July 1, 2026. Stout will be paid a monthly salary of \$3,651.96 out of the Sheriff general salary account. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Rose, Aye and Fleming, Aye.

This is bond from the owner of cattle owner that was seized by the Sheriff due to cruelty to animals. This will be used to pay vendors that picked up and transported cattle and housing and feeding the cattle. Case #CF-2026-00009 & CV-2026-00008. Yeomans informed the Board that after last weeks Officer Meeting she pulled the statute regarding vacation time. Per Title 19 §19-1301 regarding Vacation and sick leave. It states "Each county may develop and maintain a formal plan for vacation and sick leave for all regular employees. No person chosen by election or appointment to fill an elective office shall be subject to any leave plan, nor shall such person be eligible for accrual of any leave benefits. Any leave plan adopted by a county shall not extend benefits to any employee in excess of leave benefits available to a regular state employee in the classified service. Yeomans stated "we are under the amount the state provides." So, it sounds like we can implement vacation and sick leave benefits to employees how we choose to.
