

Beaver County, Oklahoma
County Commissioners Proceedings
June 22, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on June 22, 2026. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on June 17, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Fleming called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Roy Fleming, Chairman; Kerry Regier, Vice-Chairman; C.J. Rose, Member; Scott Mitchell, Sheriff; Mary Chris Barth and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the minutes of the May 18, 2026 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to accept a Donation from Blue Sage Land & Cattle on behalf of Beaver County Sheriff in the amount of \$6,010.00, Receipt #544, deposited in the Sheriff Donation Account. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Rose, Aye and Regier, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to accept a Donation from Beaver County Stockyards on behalf of Balko FD in memory of Jack Morris in the amount of \$150.00, Receipt #543, deposited in the Balko FD Donation Account. Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the Resolution for Disposing of Equipment for Dist. 3 as follows. New grader cost \$455,740.00 less trade in of \$273,500.00.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Rose to approve the FY27 Agreement between Beaver Co. Health Dept. and Deal Refrigeration Heating and Air for maintenance of heat/air units for a fee of \$370.00. Additional fees will be applied if parts are needed. Motion carried with voting; Fleming, Aye; Rose, Aye and Regier, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the FY27 contract between Beaver Co. Health Dept. and Northwest Shredders for \$25.00 per console per pick up. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Rose, Aye; and Fleming, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the FY27 Interagency Agreement between Oklahoma Dept. Of Public Safety, Beaver County Health Dept. and Board of County Commissioners to provide antennas at site of Health Dept. to allow the OHP to be able to upload Data. Term of agreement will be from July 1, 2026 and ending on June 30, 2027. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the FY27 contract between Beaver Co. Health Dept. and Summit Technology (Toshiba) for copier fees. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Rose, Aye; and Fleming, Aye.

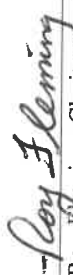

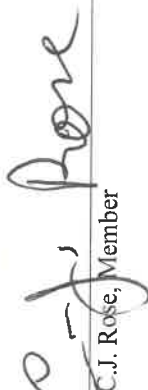
There being no other business to come before the board at this time, the board adjourned at 10:48 a.m. Voting; Fleming, Aye; Regier, Aye and Rose, Aye.
