The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners July 1, 2026. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on June 26, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West, and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

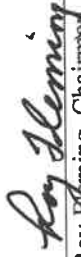

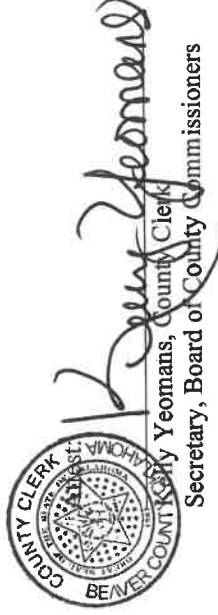
