

Beaver County, Oklahoma
County Commissioners Proceedings
July 20, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on June 22, 2026. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on June 17, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Fleming called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Roy Fleming, Chairman; Kerry Regier, Vice-Chairman; C.J. Rose, Member; Scott Mitchell, Sheriff; Mary Chris Barth and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Regier to approve the minutes of the June 13, 2026 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Rose, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Regier, Aye.

10:00 ~ Peggy Morrison with the Beaver Pioneer Memorial Park Association was here to discuss getting a lease/easement agreement north of Beaver where the communications tower sits and was recently destroyed by severe weather. In the past there was never an official agreement between the county and the park association. The park association would like a written agreement to be no greater than 50 years. They do not want any monetary compensation. They recommend fencing be placed around the tower and if the county ever decided to not have the tower due to other technology in the future, they ask that the land be restored back to its natural state. If they have any questions, they can contact her or Chris Berry. The Commissioners will have our District Attorney draw up a lease/easement agreement. Once we receive it, we will get a copy to the association to review. Upon approval we will place it on the agenda for official signatures of all parties.

OSU agrees to pay an annual amount of \$3,600.00 for office space and utilities for a period from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.
