County Commissioners Proceedings
August 17, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Office of the County Commissioners on August 17, 2026. Notice of the meeting was posted for public information on August 13, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. at the East, West and North entrances to the Beaver County Courthouse and www.beaver.okcounties.org.

Fleming called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Those present were Roy Fleming, Chairman; Kerry Regier, Vice-Chairman; C.J. Rose, Member; Scott Mitchell, Sheriff and Kelly Yeomans, County Clerk/Secretary.

Motion was made by Fleming and seconded by Rose to approve the minutes of the August 10, 2026 meeting. Motion carried with voting; Regier, Aye; Fleming, Aye and Rose, Aye.

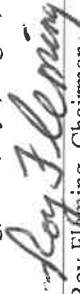

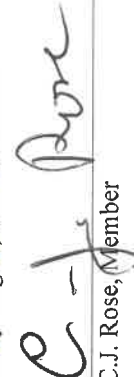
